

MOST INFLUENTIAL WOMEN (MIW) AWARDS

HELD AND HOSTED BY: CEO COMMUNICATIONS (PTY) LTD

The Terms and Conditions contained herein will regulate and govern the MOST INFLUENTIAL WOMEN AWARDS ("MIW") and all Participants and those nominating such participants. (*Alternate references to "award" and "competition" should be read as meaning MIW*)

MIW AND PROMOTIONS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. To qualify for the awards, participants must reside in the Republic of South Africa and must be South African citizens. Participants will have to present a valid South African identity document (ID) or a valid South African passport;
2. The deadline for the awards or promotions is stated on promotional material for each award. Late entries will not be accepted;
3. Participants must submit a comprehensive curriculum vitae, with the required supporting documentation and proof of qualifications (if any) and work experience. Participants will also submit a recent high-resolution photograph. All supporting documentation must be stamped and verified as an authentic document by a Commissioner of Oaths. Supporting documentation not verified in this manner automatically disqualifies the entrant. Persons nominating any participants must ensure that documents submitted on behalf of such a participant complies with these terms and conditions;
4. Award nominees' entry forms will conclude with a statement by all participants that, to the best of their knowledge, the contents of the entry form are true and correct;
5. CEO reserves the right to verify any entrant's information;
6. The outcome of the awards is subject to the decision of the judges appointed for the different rounds of the contest, and whose decision is final. No negotiations will be entered into regarding the decision of the judges;
7. The participant agrees not to hold CEO responsible for any damages, losses, claims and/or actions of any kind, including those of third parties, in connection with the contest and promotion thereof. The participant further indemnifies CEO without limitation against claims for personal injuries, death and property damage, and claims based on publicity rights, defamation or invasion of privacy;
8. CEO reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel or suspend or change any contest or promotion;
9. In the event where the award or promotion is cancelled, suspended or changed, all participants agree to waive any rights that they may have in terms of the award or promotion and acknowledge that they have no recourse against CEO, CEO's employees, agents, partners, suppliers, sponsors and/or promoters;
10. The agreement or transaction entered into, or payment made by or under it, would not give rise to any legal relationship, rights, duties or consequences whatsoever, nor enforceable in law;
11. Winners of the various categories of the awards will be notified via electronic mail or telephone and CEO shall be entitled to publish information and results on its website and/or any of its publications;
12. Should CEO decide to issue the winners with prizes and framed certificates, and the prizes or certificates should not be claimed within 30 (thirty) days of such a prize-winner being announced, the prize-winner forfeits the prize and CEO reserves the right to re-award or dispose of the prize on its sole discretion;
13. Prizes may not be exchanged for cash or any other prize, nor are they transferable;
14. Participants must be over the age of 18 (eighteen) at the time of the competition, unless otherwise stipulated at CEO's sole discretion;
15. CEO reserves the right to limit the number of entries made by any one participant or entrant for a competition;
16. CEO and its agents are not responsible for lost, delayed, misdirected, unintelligible and/or incomplete electronic mail, telephone, electronic hardware and software programme, network, Internet and computer malfunctions, failures and difficulties, errors in transmission or any condition caused by events beyond the control of CEO which may cause the competition and promotion to be disrupted or corrupted;
17. Winners of specific categories of the awards accept that certain other conditions may apply as prescribed by CEO or the respective sponsor of the specific competition or promotion;
18. Subject to sponsor conditions or other agreements, CEO undertakes to deliver prizes to respective winners only where such winners are located and reside within the geographical area defined by the specific competition and promotion. Winners resident or located anywhere outside of the defined area will be liable for any costs incurred by the collection or receipt of any prize(s) that they have won;

Participants authorise CEO to publish or distribute any/all the details of the participant and/or to take pictures of the participant or use the participant's details or photographs in any advertising or promotional material without liability on the part of CEO, including any remuneration for the use of such material;
20. Any violation or attempt to violate any of the above terms and conditions will result in the immediate disqualification of the participant;
21. By participating in any awards or competition hosted partly or in whole by CEO, participants further agree to be bound by the Terms and Conditions of CEO's website;
22. CEO will not be held responsible for any mistakes or discrepancies contained in any promotional material;
23. Participants agree that they will make themselves available for future road shows/interviews during their reign as winner/runner-up;

Finalists in the individual sectors must attend face-to-face interviews in any of the following regions: Friday, 21 May in Bloemfontein, Wednesday, 24 – 26 May in Johannesburg, Thursday, 27 May in Durban, Friday, 28 May in Port Elizabeth, or Monday 31 May in Cape Town. Venues of these to be confirmed per e-mail or phone.
25. Participants agree to be interviewed by the media;
26. No one acting as a judge for the competition is eligible to enter, nor to judge the entry of a company or department he or she may be involved with in any capacity;
27. At the conclusion of the awards, all copies of submissions will be destroyed and therefore not returned. Participants are therefore advised to keep copies of submissions, supporting documentation and other attachments;
28. CEO is entitled, at its sole discretion, to retain photographs, videos or documentation received from or taken of any participant, during the awards, for promotional, marketing purposes, or any other purpose whatsoever;
29. Previous winners are not allowed to enter again;
30. CEO reserves the right to re-award any prize to the runner-up in any category should the winner of such a category be disqualified for non-compliance with these terms and conditions at any time;
